In the past, our Youth have gathered before Mass and spent the first half of Mass discussing the Sunday Gospel. It is my preference as pastor that they attend the entire Eucharist and then gather afterwards to discuss their entire worship experience. They may wish to comment on any of the four scriptures read, the homily or the celebration of Mass itself.

I feel this revised format will offer students an expanded opportunity for greater learning. I am also persuaded that our Youth are sufficiently mature enough to benefit from a far more comprehensive worship experience.

Hopefully, we will be able to evaluate our new program after the summer and decide whether we wish to continue it as is or modify it further.
