The oldest thrift store in the Conejo Valley, The Mad Attic, is joining with the Conejo Compassion Coalition, a non-profit corporation serving the needy when disaster strikes, to raise funds to aid the victims in Louisiana from the horrific flooding that has ravaged that state.

The Mad Attic is open from 10:00am to 4:00pm, Tuesday through Saturday. Starting Sept. 1<sup>st</sup> and continuing through Sept. 3<sup>rd</sup>, every dollar from sales will go to relief efforts in Louisiana. There is no overhead and no staff to be paid, every single dollar from sales those days will go directly to relief efforts. Bob Bland, President of the CCC, and Mary Ann Palmquist, President, and Ruthanne England, Vice President, of The Mad Attic, recognized the catastrophe that happened when entire towns were flooded, and quickly joined forces to help.
