A Message from Your Rector

Dear Friends,

This Sunday, June 10, our seminarian, KC Robertson, will bring us a word from the Lord. I am excited to hear from KC, who has finished her second “middler” year at seminary. Our community raised her up as a lay leader, and then identified her as someone who may have a call to ordained ministry. The Diocesan Commission on Ministry also supported our discernment that KC is called to Holy Orders and sent her to graduate school for her theological education. Throughout her seminary experience, our community has supported KC financially with two grants per year. These grants go towards her tuition, a portion of which is funded by the Diocese of Los Angeles, but the rest is up to KC and her family and us!

This Sunday I will make a request to the congregation for additional financial support for KC's books and living expenses for her last year. Many of you already have given generously, and on behalf of KC and her family, I offer you great thanks. For those who would like to help further or give for the first time, please be aware that any amount of support is appreciated and joyfully accepted. You can find envelopes at the back of the church on both sides designated as gifts towards KC's education. Please add your donations to these envelopes and place them into the offering plate. Please make your checks to “The Parish of St. Patrick” with “Seminarian Fund” written in the Memo. We will collect the donations and make sure KC receives them.

Thank you for your generosity and your commitment to supporting KC in her work for the kingdom of God in this place and beyond! And remember: whether you are able to give financially or not, your loving prayers for KC as she enters this last year of seminary education and continued discernment are essential to her success. Pray. Pray often.
